

## VIGIWATER™ : water quality and biological impact

### *Micro-pollutants, complex pollution, toxicity :*

**VIGIWATER™** is the new water quality evaluation service offered by VigiCell.

VIGIWATER™ allows assessment of a water sample on living material thanks to a panel of more than 20 bioassays specially selected in regards to the EU Water Framework Directive and its emerging micro-pollutant monitoring requirements. These assays solve the need for data in the four major fields of general toxicity, endocrine disruptions, genotoxicity and cellular stress.

The relevance of this new service has been endorsed by obtaining a procurement contract from the Seine-Normandy basin agency in July 2011: "Implementation and interpretation of chronic toxicity biological assays on several effluent types discharged in the Seine-Normandy basin."
